The facts about organ donation

In 2010, there were 6 donors in Moncton (with a total of 29 organs retrieved) and 2 donors in Saint John (with a total of 9 organs retrieved). In 2010, 19 people in New Brunswick were transplanted. As of April 1st 2011, there were 4,167 people in Canada waiting for an organ transplant, 71 percent of these patients are waiting for a kidney transplant.



In New Brunswick, there are:

- 99 Kidney patients
- 18 Liver patients
- 37 Heart patients
- and **multiple** lung and pancreas patients
