



## **Intra - Provincial**

### **IWK**

- Organ coordinators and RTB invited to be part of their accreditation team
- provide ongoing education and support to organ/tissue donor initiatives

## Capital Health

MDE workshops and general education to Palliative Care,
8.4, Surgical Grand Rounds, coffee cart education



## Inter-Provincial

**New Brunswick** – ongoing auditing and training relationship, import corneas and other tissue for processing and distribution

**Newfoundland** – heart valve MOU for donors not eligible for whole organ donation

**Hema-Quebec** – visit to our program, established agreement for importing excess corneas to CDHA for use in our cornea transplant program, on going processing heart valves/tendons on their behalf

**PEI** – MOU, remote cornea program, June visit MDE Workshop to multidisciplines and cornea recovery training









## Research

#### Skin Decellularization - Dalhousie

•involves extracting cellular materials (source of immune response and viruses) from allograft tissues leaving an intact, structurally native extra-cellular matrix scaffold (collagen, elastin, proteoglycans).1 The decellularization process has the potential to provide a safer and more sterile graft by removing bacteria and viruses.

### Heart - PI Dr. G. Hirsch Cardiac Surgery CDHA

- •To examine there exists a significant burden of coronary atherosclerosis in a population of patients who would be potential heart transplant donors.
- •The Regional Tissue Bank recovers valves from approximately 20 donors per year for homograft valve replacements. As part of the consent process, the donating family has the opportunity to allow the remaining tissue to be used for research. When the Tissue Bank receives a heart with the appropriate research consent obtained, we will contact the research team in order to coordinate transfer of the heart post tissue recovery.
